Maintaining Your Union Membership

Upon retirement, any member of a NYSUT local automatically becomes a NYSUT and AFT retiree member. If your local provides for retiree membership, you must remain a member in your local to maintain your membership in NYSUT and AFT. If your local requires retiree dues, payment of those dues is a requirement for local, NYSUT and AFT retiree membership.

Your NEA membership can continue with a one-time payment of \$300 for a lifetime membership, or you may take advantage of other payment options that the NEA offers retired members. You must maintain your NYSUT membership (to maintain any NEA member benefits) if you want to participate in any of the NEA Member Benefits programs.

Your union continues to fight for your rights, your pension and all that you've earned in your professional career.
